Hello 8th District Legion Auxiliary President, Secretaries and Membership Chairman

I hope you are all well. I know that 2020 has brought many challenges, from the COVID-19 pandemic and civil unrest, both can make it difficult and sometimes impossible to operate. It is my hope that both the pandemic and the civil unrest will pass soon. On July 6 2020 I sent 134 letters to our unpaid 2020 members in the 8th District encouraging them to renew and if they were not going to renew to please let me know why. As of the writing of this letter we still have 120 unrenewed 2020 memberships. Please reach out to your members who have not renewed and check on them. Hopefully, it is just an oversite. If you are having trouble contact those members, please let me know. Now onto 2021 membership year. By now all units should have their 2021 membership packet, if not please contact me **immediately**. The first email renewal notices have already gone out and the first snail mail renewal notice will go out on September 15, 2020. The district is currently processing membership for three units (Orr, Mt. Iron and Biwabik). We will be contacting those unit members to determine their unit's viability moving forward. If your unit is struggling please contact me so that we can help find the best way to revitalize or begin the process of turning in your charter. There is a process for both.

Unit Goals - Enclosed you will find a list of the 8th District Units and there closing 2020 membership numbers, along with their 2021 membership goals. Membership goals are determined by national. For units with 150 members and above on July 31st two shall be added as their goal for the following year. For units with 149 and below on July 31st one shall be added as their goal for the following year. Example If your unit has 130 members as of July 31st your unit's goal would be 131. If your unit has 160 members as of July 31st your unit goal would be 162.

I have also included a blank officers list for 2021, please complete the form and return it to me weather you have sent one to department or not. Officers list provide a line of communication between National, Department and District.
